5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. The heading to Subchapter H, Chapter 1952,
7	Insurance Code, is amended to read as follows:
8	SUBCHAPTER H. NAMED DRIVER POLICIES, OPERATOR'S POLICIES, AND
9	CERTAIN OTHER EXCLUSIONARY POLICIES
10	SECTION 2. Subchapter H, Chapter 1952, Insurance Code, is
11	amended by adding Section 1952.354 to read as follows:
12	Sec. 1952.354. POOL FOR OPERATOR'S POLICIES AND CERTAIN
13	EXCLUSIONARY POLICIES. (a) This section applies only to an insurer
14	writing an automobile insurance policy that:
15	(1) is an operator's policy; or
16	(2) excludes from coverage an individual who has
17	permission to use a covered vehicle from the named insured.
18	(b) The commissioner shall establish a pool for paying the
19	deductible incurred by a person with a valid claim against an
20	individual who is excluded from coverage under a policy described
21	by Subsection (a). The commissioner by rule shall establish and
22	maintain a system for an eligible person to apply for reimbursement
23	by the pool.
24	(c) The department may assess an insurer to which this

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1	section applies to provide money to operate the pool. The amount
2	assessed against an insurer must be in proportion to the insurer's
3	writing of policies described by Subsection (a) in this state.
4	(d) The department may bring an action to collect an
5	assessment against an insurer that does not pay the assessment
6	within a reasonable time.
7	(e) The commissioner may adopt rules necessary to implement
8	this section.

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9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
