(a) Subject to Subsection (b), a 12 13 hospital or other health facility may discharge or otherwise release a patient to the care of a group home, boarding home 14 15 facility, or similar group-centered facility only if the person who operates the group-centered facility holds a license or permit 16 17 issued in accordance with applicable state law. (b) A hospital or other health facility may discharge or 18 otherwise release a patient to the care of a group home, boarding 19 home facility, or similar group-centered facility operated by a 20 person who does not hold a license or permit issued in accordance 21 22 with applicable state law only if:

- 9 <u>authorizing a hospital or health facility to discharge or release a</u>
- 10 patient to a group-centered facility in a manner that conflicts

- 12 SECTION 3. Section 256.003(c), Health and Safety Code, as
- 13 added by this Act, applies only to a cause of action that accrues on
- 14 or after the effective date of this Act.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
