5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subtitle A, Title 9, Health and Safety Code, is
7	amended by adding Chapter 769 to read as follows:
8	CHAPTER 769. REGULATION OF CERTAIN GROUP HOMES
9	Sec. 769.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "group home"
10	means an establishment that:
11	(1) provides, in one or more buildings, lodging to
12	three or more residents who are unrelated by blood or marriage to
13	the owner of the establishment; and
14	(2) provides those residents with community meals,
15	light housework, meal preparation, transportation, grocery
16	shopping, money management, laundry services, or assistance with
17	self-administration of medication but does not provide personal
18	care services as defined by Section 247.002.
19	Sec. 769.002. EXEMPTIONS. This chapter does not apply to:
20	(1) a person who holds a license issued under Chapter
21	142, 242, 246, 247, or 252;
22	(2) a person, establishment, or facility exempt from
23	licensing under Section 142.003(a)(19), 242.003(3), or 247.004(4);
24	(3) a hotel as defined by Section 156.001, Tax Code;

- 2 <u>(5)</u> a monastery or convent;
- 3 (6) a child-care facility as defined by Section
- 4 42.002, Human Resources Code;
- 5 (7) a family violence shelter center as defined by

- 7 (8) a sorority or fraternity house or other dormitory
- 8 associated with an institution of higher education.
- 9 Sec. 769.003. CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD INFORMATION
- 10 REQUIREMENT FOR APPLICANTS AND EMPLOYEES; CRIMINAL PENALTY. (a)
- 11 An owner or operator of a group home shall obtain criminal history
- 12 record information maintained by the Department of Public Safety of
- 13 the State of Texas on each individual who is an applicant for
- 14 employment with or an employee of the group home.
- 15 (b) An owner or operator of a group home may not hire or
- 16 continue to employ an individual for whom the owner or operator
- 17 obtains criminal history record information on the applicant's or
- 18 employee's conviction of an offense under Chapter 19, 20, 20A, 21,
- 19 <u>22, 25, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 33A, 34, 35, 35A, 48, or 7</u>1, Penal
- 20 Code, or any other offense punishable as a Class A misdemeanor or a
- 21 felony.
- (c) An owner or operator of a group home who violates
- 23 Subsection (b) commits an offense. An offense under this section is
- 24 a Class A misdemeanor.
- 25 SECTION 2. Section 769.003, Health and Safety Code, as
- 26 added by this Act, applies only to an application for employment
- 27 submitted on or after the effective date of this Act.
