## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the creation of the criminal offense of residential
- 3 picketing.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 42.04(a) and (c), Penal Code, are
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) If conduct that would otherwise violate Section
- 8 42.01(a)(5) (Unreasonable Noise), 42.03 (Obstructing Passageway),
- 9 [or] 42.055 (Funeral Service Disruptions), or 42.056 (Residential
- 10 Picketing) consists of speech or other communication, of gathering
- 11 with others to hear or observe such speech or communication, or of
- 12 gathering with others to picket or otherwise express in a
- 13 nonviolent manner a position on social, economic, political, or
- 14 religious questions, the actor must be ordered to move, disperse,
- 15 or otherwise remedy the violation prior to the actor's [his] arrest
- 16 if the actor [he] has not yet intentionally harmed the interests of
- 17 others which those sections seek to protect.
- 18 (c) It is a defense to prosecution under Section
- 19 42.01(a)(5), 42.03, [or] 42.055, or 42.056:
- 20 (1) that in circumstances in which this section
- 21 requires an order no order was given;
- 22 (2) that an order, if given, was manifestly
- 23 unreasonable in scope; or
- 24 (3) that an order, if given, was promptly obeyed.

- 1 SECTION 2. Chapter 42, Penal Code, is amended by adding
- 2 Section 42.056 to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 42.056. RESIDENTIAL PICKETING. (a) In this section:
- 4 (1) "Dwelling" means any structure or part of a
- 5 structure that is occupied as, or designed or intended for
- 6 occupancy as, a residence by one or more individuals.
- 7 (2) "Picketing" means:
- 8 (A) standing, sitting, or repeated walking,
- 9 riding, driving, or other similar action by a person displaying or
- 10 carrying a banner, placard, or sign;
- 11 (B) engaging in loud singing, chanting,
- 12 whistling, or yelling, with or without noise amplification through
- 13 a device such as a bullhorn or microphone; or
- 14 (C) blocking access to a dwelling.
- 15 (b) A person commits an offense if the person engages in
- 16 picketing before or about the dwelling of any individual with the
- 17 intent to harass or disturb the individual in the individual's
- 18 dwelling.
- 19 (c) An offense under this section is a Class B misdemeanor.
- 20 (d) If conduct constituting an offense under this section
- 21 also constitutes an offense under another law, the actor may be
- 22 prosecuted under this section, the other law, or both.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
