## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the procedure for delivery by a chief appraiser of a
- 3 form for reapplying for the appraisal of land for ad valorem tax
- 4 purposes as agricultural or open-space land.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 23.43(e), Tax Code, is amended to read as 7 follows:
- 8 (e) Before February 1 the chief appraiser shall deliver an
- 9 application form by certified mail, return receipt requested, to
- 10 each individual whose land was designated for agricultural use
- 11 during the preceding year. The chief appraiser [He] shall include
- 12 with the application a brief explanation of the requirements for
- 13 obtaining agricultural designation.
- SECTION 2. Section 23.54(e), Tax Code, is amended to read as
- 15 follows:
- 16 (e) If a person fails to file a valid application on time,
- 17 the land is ineligible for appraisal as provided by this subchapter
- 18 for that year. Once an application is filed and appraisal under this
- 19 subchapter is allowed, the land is eligible for appraisal under
- 20 this subchapter in subsequent years without a new application
- 21 unless the ownership of the land changes or its eligibility under
- 22 this subchapter ends. However, subject to Section 23.551, if the
- 23 chief appraiser has good cause to believe that land is no longer
- 24 eligible for appraisal under this subchapter, the chief appraiser

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- 1 may require a person allowed appraisal under this subchapter in a
- 2 prior year to file a new application to confirm that the land is
- 3 currently eligible for appraisal under this subchapter by
- 4 delivering a written notice that a new application is required,
- 5 accompanied by the application form,  $\underline{\text{by certified mail, return}}$
- 6 receipt requested, to the person who filed the application that was
- 7 previously allowed.
- 8 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 9 a notice or application form delivered by the chief appraiser of an
- 10 appraisal district on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
