18	to reduce reliance on 9-1-1 transports and systems for routine

21	(d) A reference in this chapter to the district providing
22	emergency services includes preventive health care services.
23	(e) A district may make necessary improvements and adopt

(f) A district in a county with a population of less than 60,000 must obtain approval from the county commissioners court prior to providing services under this section.

4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
