- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 37.054, Utilities Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 8 (c) In addition to any notice provided under Subsection (a),
- 9 the commission shall require the applicant to provide written
- 10 notice of each substation proposed to be authorized by a
- 11 <u>certificate of convenience and necessity to each owner of:</u>
- 12 (1) property adjacent to the property on which the
- 13 substation will be located; and
- (2) property located directly across a highway, road,
- 15 or street that is adjacent to the property on which the substation
- 16 will be located.
- 17 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 18 a proceeding affecting a certificate of public convenience and
- 19 necessity that commences on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 20 A proceeding affecting a certificate of public convenience and
- 21 necessity that commenced before the effective date of this Act is
- 22 governed by the law in effect on the date the proceeding is
- 23 commenced, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
