1-21 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to the issuance or amendment of a certificate of public
 1-24 convenience and necessity that authorizes the construction of an
 1-25 electrical substation.

1-26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-27 SECTION 1. Section 37.054, Utilities Code, is amended by
 1-28 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

1-29 (c) In addition to any notice provided under Subsection (a),
 1-30 the commission shall require the applicant to provide written
 1-31 notice of each substation proposed to be authorized by the
 1-32 certificate to each owner of:

1-33 (1) property adjacent to the property on which the
 1-34 substation will be located; and

1-35 (2) property located directly across a highway, road,
 1-36 or street that is adjacent to the property on which the substation
 1-37 will be located.

1-38 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
 1-39 a proceeding affecting a certificate of public convenience and
 1-40 necessity that commences on or after the effective date of this Act.
 1-41 A proceeding affecting a certificate of public convenience and
 1-42 necessity that commenced before the effective date of this Act is
 1-43 governed by the law in effect on the date the proceeding is
 1-44 commenced, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.

1-45 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
