- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 51.302, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 8 (d) A college or university receiving state support or state
- 9 aid from public funds that does not offer at least three semester
- 10 <u>credit hours or the equivalent in Texas History to undergraduate</u>
- 11 students shall enter into an agreement with another postsecondary
- 12 educational institution to offer to the college or university's
- 13 undergraduate students at least three semester credit hours or the
- 14 <u>equivalent in Texas History.</u>
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024
- 16 academic year.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
