- subchapter only if its junior college district[+ 10
- 11 [(1) had a taxable property valuation amount of not
- 12 less than \$6 billion in the preceding year; and
- $[\frac{(2)}{2}]$ received a positive assessment of the overall 13
- 14 financial health of the district as reported by the coordinating
- board. 15
- SECTION 2. Section 16 130.307(b-1), Education Code, is
- repealed. 17
- 18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 19
- provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 20
- Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 21
- Act takes effect September 1, 2023. 22
