A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to training requirements for public school board of trustees members and superintendents regarding the adoption of a 3 trauma-informed school standard. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 11, Education Code, is 7 amended by adding Section 11.004 to read as follows: Sec. 11.004. TRAINING FOR SCHOOL BOARD MEMBERS AND 8 SUPERINTENDENTS REGARDING TRAUMA-INFORMED SCHOOL STANDARD. (a) A 9 member of the board of trustees and the superintendent of a school 10 11 district must complete an agency-approved course of instruction 12 regarding the adoption and administration of a trauma-informed school standard. A course required under this section must be 13 14 completed on an annual basis. 15 (b) A course of instruction described by Subsection (a) must 16 provide information, relevant to and within the scope of the duties of a school board member or superintendent, regarding: 17 18 (1) recognition of and care for trauma in students and 19 educators; 20 (2) the relationship between educator wellness and 21 student learning; 22 (3) the effect of trauma on student behavior and 23 learning; 24 (4) the prevalence of trauma among students, including

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1 the prevalence of trauma among student populations at higher risk 2 of experiencing trauma; 3 (5) the effects of implicit or explicit bias on 4 recognizing trauma among various racial or ethnic groups of 5 students; and 6 (6) effective district and campus policies and 7 practices shown to: 8 (A) prevent and mitigate the negative effect of trauma on student behavior and learning; and 9 10 (B) support the emotional wellness of educators. (c) A school district shall submit for agency approval any 11 12 course of instruction identified by the district as satisfying the requirements of Subsection (b). 13 14 (d) The agency may approve both in-person and online courses 15 of instruction to satisfy the requirements of this section, including courses provided by community-based nonprofit 16 17 organizations with expertise concerning trauma-informed school standards. 18

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19 SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2023, the Texas 20 Education Agency shall approve one or more courses of instruction 21 to satisfy the training requirements of Section 11.004, Education 22 Code, as added by this Act.

23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 27 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
