1-21 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to the value of a residential dwelling offered or awarded  
 1-24 as a prize at a charitable raffle.

1-25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-26 SECTION 1. Section 2002.056(b-1), Occupations Code, is  
 1-27 amended to read as follows:

1-28 (b-1) The value of a residential dwelling offered or awarded  
 1-29 as a prize at a raffle that is purchased by the organization or for  
 1-30 which the organization provides any consideration may not exceed  
 1-31 \$500,000 [~~\$250,000~~].

1-32 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only  
 1-33 to a charitable raffle conducted under Chapter 2002, Occupations  
 1-34 Code, for which a residential dwelling is offered or awarded as a  
 1-35 prize on or after the effective date of this Act. A charitable  
 1-36 raffle conducted under Chapter 2002, Occupations Code, for which a  
 1-37 residential dwelling is offered or awarded as a prize before the  
 1-38 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the  
 1-39 date the prize was offered or awarded, and the former law is  
 1-40 continued in effect for that purpose.

1-41 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
