1-21 relating to the enforcement of commercial motor vehicle safety 1-22 standards in certain municipalities.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 644.101(b), Transportation Code, amended to read as follows:
