- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 2166, Government Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Section 2166.0611 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 2166.0611. BUILDING DEDICATION CEREMONY. (a) The
- 7 commission may hold a ceremony to dedicate a new state building.
- 8 (b) Subject to Subsection (c), the commission may use
- 9 available appropriated money or donated money to pay for the
- 10 ceremony.
- 11 (c) Notwithstanding any other law, the commission may use
- 12 not more than \$20,000 of appropriated money to purchase food,
- 13 <u>nonalcoholic beverages</u>, flowers, decorations, and other items
- 14 appropriate for the ceremony that the commission would otherwise be
- 15 prohibited from purchasing.
- 16 (d) The commission may accept gifts, grants, or donations
- 17 from any source for the purposes of this section.
- 18 <u>(e) This section does not authorize the commission to</u>
- 19 purchase alcoholic beverages.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
