

AN ACT

relating to the authority of certain counties to cancel platted subdivisions that have remained undeveloped.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 232.0085(a), Local Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

(a) This section applies only to real property that ~~located~~:

(1) ~~[outside municipalities and the extraterritorial jurisdiction of municipalities, as determined under Chapter 42; and~~

~~(2)]~~ is located in the unincorporated area of an affected county, as defined by Section 16.341, Water Code, that:

(A) has adopted the model rules developed under Section 16.343, Water Code; ~~and~~

(B) is located along an international border; and

(2) if the area is located in the extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality, is not subject to a written agreement under Section 242.001 that authorizes the municipality to regulate subdivision plats and approve related permits in the extraterritorial jurisdiction.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
