5	SECTION 1. Section 232.0085(a), Local Government Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(a) This section applies only to real property <u>that</u>
8	[located]:
9	(1) [outside municipalities and the extraterritorial
10	jurisdiction of municipalities, as determined under Chapter 42; and
11	$[\frac{(2)}{2}]$ is located in the unincorporated area of an
12	affected county, as defined by Section 16.341 , Water Code, that:
13	(A) has adopted the model rules developed under
14	Section 16.343, Water Code $\underline{;}[_{m{ au}}]$ and
15	(B) is located along an international border; and
16	(2) if the area is located in the extraterritorial
17	jurisdiction of a municipality, is not subject to a written
18	agreement under Section 242.001 that authorizes the municipality to
19	regulate subdivision plats and approve related permits in the
20	extraterritorial jurisdiction.
21	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
