Section 232.0085(a), Local Government Code, is 5 amended to read as follows: 6 7 (a) This section applies only to real property that [<del>located</del>]: 8 [outside municipalities and the extraterritorial 9 (1)jurisdiction of municipalities, as determined under Chapter 42; and 10 11  $\left[\frac{1}{2}\right]$  is located in the unincorporated area of an 12 affected county, as defined by Section 16.341, Water Code, that: (A) has adopted the model rules developed under 13 14 Section 16.343, Water Code;  $[\tau]$  and (B) is located along an international border; and 15 16 (2) if the area is located in the extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality, is not subject to a written 17 agreement under Section 242.001 that authorizes the municipality to 18 regulate subdivision plats and approve related permits in the 19 extraterritorial jurisdiction. 20 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
