BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 393, Government Code, is amended by adding Section 393.1035 to read as follows: 1-25 1-26

1-27 1-28 Sec. 393.1035. CRIMINAL PENALTY. (a) A delegate or alternate delegate commits an offense if the delegate or alternate 1-29 delegate knowingly casts an unauthorized vote. 1-30

(b) An offense under this section is a state jail felony.

(c) A judge granting community supervision to a defendant convicted of an offense under this section shall require as a condition of community supervision that the defendant submit to not 1-31 1-32 1-33 less than 10 days of confinement in county jail. If a sentence of 1-34 confinement is imposed on the revocation of community supervision, 1-35 1-36 the term of confinement served under this subsection may not be credited toward completion of the sentence imposed.
