4 (4) a surviving spouse, parent, child, or sibling of a
5 person who died while serving in the United States armed forces.

6 (c) The holder of a state parklands passport issued on or before August 31, 1995, a person whose birth date is before 7 8 September 1, 1930, or a person [veteran] described by Subsection (a)(2) or (a)(4) is entitled to enter any state park without payment 9 of an entrance or admission fee. When a fee is charged by the 10 department for entrance of a vehicle into a state park, the vehicle 11 of the holder of a state parklands passport is exempt from the fee 12 when the holder is present. 13
