## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 521.060(a) and (c), Transportation Code, are amended to read as follows: 6
- (a) The department shall maintain in its files a record of 7
- the name, address, and telephone number of each individual 8
- identified by the holder of a driver's license or personal 9
- identification certificate as an individual the holder authorizes 10
- 11 to be contacted in the event that the holder is injured or dies in or
- 12 as a result of a vehicular accident or another emergency situation.
- In addition, the department shall maintain in its files a record of 13
- 14 any medical information described by Section 521.125(a) that is
- provided to the department under Subsection (c) or any health 15
- condition information that is voluntarily provided to 16
- department under <u>Sections 521.1251 and</u> [Section] 521.142(h). 17
- 18 An application for an original, renewal, or duplicate
- driver's license or personal identification certificate must: 19
- (1) be designed to allow, but not require, 20
- 21 applicant to provide:

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- 22 the name, address, and telephone number of
- 23 not more than two individuals to be contacted if the applicant is
- injured or dies in a circumstance described by Subsection (a); and 24

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- 1 (B) in addition to health condition information
- 2 voluntarily provided under Sections 521.1251 and [Section]
- 3 521.142(h), medical information described by Section 521.125(a);
- 4 and
- 5 (2) include a statement that:
- 6 (A) describes the confidential nature of the
- 7 information; and
- 8 (B) states that by providing the department with
- 9 the information, the applicant consents to the limited disclosure
- 10 and use of the information.
- 11 SECTION 2. Subchapter F, Chapter 521, Transportation Code,
- 12 is amended by adding Section 521.1251 to read as follows:
- 13 <u>Sec. 521.1251. OPTIONAL HEALTH CONDITION OR DISABILITY</u>
- 14 DESIGNATION. (a) The department shall provide to each applicant
- 15 for the issuance of an original, renewal, corrected, or duplicate
- 16 <u>driver's license or personal identification certificate who</u>
- 17 applies in person, by mail, over the Internet, or by other
- 18 electronic means the opportunity to voluntarily indicate on a
- 19 driver's license or personal identification certificate that the
- 20 person has a health condition or disability that may impede
- 21 effective communication with a peace officer. The department may
- 22 request from a person who makes an indication under this subsection
- 23 <u>verification of a condition in the form of:</u>
- 24 (1) for a physical health condition, a written
- 25 statement from a licensed physician; or
- 26 (2) for a mental health condition, a written statement
- 27 from a licensed physician, a licensed psychologist, or a

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- 1 non-physician mental health professional, as defined by Section
- 2 <u>571.003</u>, Health and Safety Code.
- 3 (b) The department shall include a designation that
- 4 indicates the person has a health condition or disability that may
- 5 impede effective communication with a peace officer on each
- 6 driver's license or personal identification certificate issued to a
- 7 person who:
- 8 (1) makes an election under this section; and
- 9 (2) provides sufficient evidence under Subsection (a)
- 10 to qualify for the designation.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
