SECTION 4. Section 250.0035, Health and Safety Code, is amended by adding Subsection (c-1) to read as follows:

3 (c-1) Chapter 53, Occupations Code, does not apply to the 4 issuance or renewal of a nurse aide's certificate of registration 5 or an applicant's inclusion in the nurse aide registry under this 6 section.

7 SECTION 5. The changes in law made by this Act to Chapters 242 and 250, Health and Safety Code, apply only to a license, 8 9 permit, or certificate of registration issued or renewed on or after the effective date of this Act. A license, permit, or 10 certificate of registration issued or renewed before the effective 11 date of this Act is governed by the law in effect when the license, 12 permit, or certificate was issued or renewed, and the former law is 13 continued in effect for that purpose. 14
