## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to baccalaureate degree programs offered by certain public
- 3 junior colleges.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 130.306, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (b) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), a [A] public
- 9 junior college offering a baccalaureate degree program under this
- 10 subchapter may not offer more than five baccalaureate degree
- 11 programs at any time.
- 12 (b) At any time, South Texas College may not offer more than
- 13 six baccalaureate degree programs under this subchapter. The sixth
- 14 baccalaureate degree program must be a bachelor of applied science
- 15 degree in child and family development.
- 16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
