- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1104.153, Occupations Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1104.153. APPRAISAL <u>SERVICES EXAMINATION</u> [<u>REVIEW</u>].
- 8 (a) A person who examines the work of appraisers performing
- 9 appraisal services [performs an appraisal review] for an appraisal
- 10 management company as required by Section 1104.155 must be
- 11 knowledgeable of appraisal practice and the Uniform Standards of
- 12 <u>Professional Appraisal Practice</u>[+
- [(1) licensed as an appraiser under Chapter 1103,
- 14 unless exempt by board rule; and
- 15 [(2) qualified to perform the appraisal being
- 16 reviewed].
- 17 (b) An appraisal management company registered under this
- 18 chapter shall keep a record of the qualifications of a person
- 19 conducting an examination described by Subsection (a).
- 20 SECTION 2. Section 1104.155, Occupations Code, is amended
- 21 to read as follows:
- Sec. 1104.155. PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS. An appraisal
- 23 management company registered under this chapter shall on a
- 24 periodic basis examine [perform an appraisal review of] the work of

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- 1 appraisers performing appraisal services for the company to ensure
- 2 that the services comply with:
- 3 (1) the edition of the Uniform Standards of
- 4 Professional Appraisal Practice in effect at the time of the
- 5 appraisal; or
- 6 (2) other standards prescribed by board rule.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
