## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the required period of retention of video surveillance
- 3 recordings of special education settings.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 29.022(e), Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (e) Except as provided by Subsection (e-1), a school
- 8 district or open-enrollment charter school shall retain video
- 9 recorded from a video camera placed under this section for at least
- 10 six [three] months after the date the video was recorded.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024
- 12 school year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
