1-19 relating to systems of county road administration in certain
 1-20 counties.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 252.301(d), Transportation Code, is
 1-23 amended to read as follows:

1-24 (d) Except as provided by Section 252.3011, a [A] county
 1-25 that votes to adopt this subchapter may vote in the same manner to
 1-26 discontinue use of this subchapter.

1-27 SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 252, Transportation Code,
 1-28 is amended by adding Section 252.3011 to read as follows:

1-29 Sec. 252.3011. DISCONTINUATION OF COUNTY ROAD DEPARTMENT
 1-30 SYSTEM IN CERTAIN COUNTIES. (a) This section applies only to a
 1-31 county with a population of less than 75,000 that is adjacent to
 1-32 three counties with populations of more than 450,000.

1-33 (b) The commissioners court of a county that has voted to
 1-34 adopt this subchapter may discontinue the use of this subchapter by
 1-35 an order made at a regular term of the court.

1-36 (c) The commissioners court shall enter the order in its
 1-37 minutes. The order is not required to be in any particular form,
 1-38 and substantial compliance with this section is sufficient.

1-39 (d) If the commissioners court discontinues the use of this
 1-40 subchapter, Subchapter B applies to the county.

1-41 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
