4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 161, Agriculture Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 161.0542 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 161.0542. NOTICE OF WILDLIFE DISEASE OUTBREAK. (a)
8	Notwithstanding any law restricting the disclosure of information
9	by the commission and subject to Subsection (b), if the commission
10	becomes aware of a wildlife disease outbreak on a property, the
11	commission shall provide notice of the location and nature of the
12	outbreak to:
13	(1) each owner of adjacent property; and
14	(2) the Parks and Wildlife Department.
15	(b) Subsection (a) applies only to a disease that the
16	commission has designated as reportable.
17	SECTION 2. Section 11.030(a), Parks and Wildlife Code, is
18	amended to read as follows:
19	(a) The name and address and a telephone, social security,
20	driver's license, bank account, credit card, or charge card number
21	of a person who purchases customer products, licenses, or services
22	from the department may not be disclosed, sold, rented, or traded
23	except as authorized under this section or Section 12.014, 12.103,
24	<u>or</u> 12.0251.

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1 Except as provided by Subsection (d) or (d-1), the (b) 2 department may use information collected by an employee of the department on privately owned land only for the purposes of 3 4 scientific investigations and research described in Subsection (a) and only if authorized in writing by the landowner or 5 the landowner's agent. Unless the department first obtains the written 6 7 consent of the landowner or the landowner's agent, the department 8 may not:

9 (1) use other incidental information obtained on the 10 land that does not pertain directly to the investigation or 11 research authorized under Subsection (a); or

12 (2) enter or permit the entry of any information that 13 does not pertain directly to the investigation or research 14 authorized under Subsection (a), into a database:

15 (A) maintained by the department and available to16 a person other than a department employee;

17 (B) maintained by a natural heritage program18 administered by the department; or

19 (C) established and maintained by any other 20 person.

(c) Except as provided by Subsection (d) <u>or (d-1)</u>, information collected under this section may only be reported or compiled in a manner that prevents the identification of an individual parcel or specific parcels of private property without the written consent of the landowner or the landowner's agent.

26 (d-1) The department may disclose information collected
27 under this section to the Texas Animal Health Commission as needed

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1 to carry out a governmental purpose.

2 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
