## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to disclosure of certain information by the Parks and
3	Wildlife Department or the Texas Animal Health Commission.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 161, Agriculture Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 161.0542 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 161.0542. NOTICE OF WILDLIFE DISEASE OUTBREAK.
8	Notwithstanding any law restricting the disclosure of information
9	by the commission, if the commission becomes aware of a wildlife
10	disease outbreak on a property, the commission shall provide notice
11	of the location and nature of the outbreak to:
12	(1) each owner of adjacent property; and
13	(2) the Parks and Wildlife Department.
14	SECTION 2. Section 11.030(a), Parks and Wildlife Code, is
15	amended to read as follows:

- 16 (a) The name and address and a telephone, social security,
- 17 driver's license, bank account, credit card, or charge card number
- 18 of a person who purchases customer products, licenses, or services
- 19 from the department may not be disclosed, sold, rented, or traded
- 20 except as authorized under this section or Section 12.014, 12.103,
- 21 <u>or</u> 12.0251.
- SECTION 3. Subchapter A, Chapter 12, Parks and Wildlife
- 23 Code, is amended by adding Section 12.014 to read as follows:
- Sec. 12.014. NOTICE OF WILDLIFE DISEASE OUTBREAK.

- 1 Notwithstanding any law restricting the disclosure of information
- 2 by the department, if the department becomes aware of a wildlife
- 3 disease outbreak on a property, the department shall provide notice
- 4 of the location and nature of the outbreak to:
- 5 (1) each owner of adjacent property; and
- 6 (2) the Texas Animal Health Commission.
- 7 SECTION 4. Section 12.0251(b), Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 8 amended to read as follows:
- 9 (b) The commission or the department may disclose
- 10 information described by this section only to:
- 11 (1) the landowner;
- 12 (2) another person if [unless:
- 13  $\left[\frac{(1)}{(1)}\right]$  the landowner consents to full or specified
- 14 partial disclosure of information[+] and
- 15  $\left[\frac{(2)}{2}\right]$  the consent is in writing and is attached to the
- 16 plan or recommendation report; or
- 17 (3) the Texas Animal Health Commission as needed to
- 18 carry out a governmental purpose.
- 19 SECTION 5. Section 12.103, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 20 amended by amending Subsections (b) and (c) and adding Subsection
- 21 (d-1) to read as follows:
- (b) Except as provided by Subsection (d) or (d-1), the
- 23 department may use information collected by an employee of the
- 24 department on privately owned land only for the purposes of
- 25 scientific investigations and research described in Subsection (a)
- 26 and only if authorized in writing by the landowner or the
- 27 landowner's agent. Unless the department first obtains the written

- 1 consent of the landowner or the landowner's agent, the department
- 2 may not:
- 3 (1) use other incidental information obtained on the
- 4 land that does not pertain directly to the investigation or
- 5 research authorized under Subsection (a); or
- 6 (2) enter or permit the entry of any information that
- 7 does not pertain directly to the investigation or research
- 8 authorized under Subsection (a), into a database:
- 9 (A) maintained by the department and available to
- 10 a person other than a department employee;
- 11 (B) maintained by a natural heritage program
- 12 administered by the department; or
- 13 (C) established and maintained by any other
- 14 person.
- (c) Except as provided by Subsection (d) or (d-1),
- 16 information collected under this section may only be reported or
- 17 compiled in a manner that prevents the identification of an
- 18 individual parcel or specific parcels of private property without
- 19 the written consent of the landowner or the landowner's agent.
- 20 (d-1) The department may disclose information collected
- 21 under this section to the Texas Animal Health Commission as needed
- 22 to carry out a governmental purpose.
- 23 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 27 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
