A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT
2 relating to the composition of the Texas Child Mental Health Care
3 Consortium.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 113.0052, Health and Safety Code, is
6 amended to read as follows:

7 Sec. 113.0052. COMPOSITION. The consortium is composed
8 of:

9 (1) the following health-related institutions of
10 higher education:

11 (A) Baylor College of Medicine;

12 (B) Texas A&M University System Health Science
13 Center;

14 (C) Texas Tech University Health Sciences
15 Center;

16 (D) Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center
17 at El Paso;

18 (E) University of North Texas Health Science
19 Center at Fort Worth;

20 (F) The Dell Medical School at The University of
21 Texas at Austin;

22 (G) The University of Texas M.D. Anderson Cancer
23 Center;

24 (H) The University of Texas Medical Branch at

1 Galveston;

2 (I) The University of Texas Health Science Center
3 at Houston;

4 (J) The University of Texas Health Science Center
5 at San Antonio;

6 (K) The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley
7 School of Medicine;

8 (L) The University of Texas Health Science Center
9 at Tyler; and

10 (M) The University of Texas Southwestern Medical
11 Center;

12 (2) the commission;

13 (3) the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board;

14 (4) three nonprofit organizations that focus on mental
15 health care, designated by a majority of the members described by
16 Subdivision (1); ~~and~~

17 (5) each regional education service center
18 established under Chapter 8, Education Code; and

19 (6) any other entity that the executive committee
20 considers necessary.

21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
