 1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-23 SECTION 1. Section 113.0052, Health and Safety Code, is
 1-24 amended to read as follows:
 1-25 Sec. 113.0052. COMPOSITION. The consortium is composed
 1-26 of:
 1-27 (1) the following health-related institutions of
 1-28 higher education:
 1-29 (A) Baylor College of Medicine;
 1-30 (B) Texas A&M University System Health Science
 1-31 Center;
 1-32 (C) Texas Tech University Health Sciences
 1-33 Center;
 1-34 (D) Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center
 1-35 at El Paso;
 1-36 (E) University of North Texas Health Science
 1-37 Center at Fort Worth;
 1-38 (F) The Dell Medical School at The University of

2-6 SECTION 2. Section 113.0101(a), Health and Safety Code, is
2-7 amended to read as follows:

2-8 (a) The consortium is governed by an executive committee
2-9 composed of the following members:

2-10 (1) the chair of the academic department of psychiatry
2-11 of each of the health-related institutions of higher education
2-12 listed in Section 113.0052(1) or a licensed psychiatrist, including
2-13 a child-adolescent psychiatrist, designated by the chair to serve
2-14 in the chair's place;

2-15 (2) a representative of the commission with expertise
2-16 in the delivery of mental health care services, appointed by the
2-17 executive commissioner;

2-18 (3) a representative of the commission with expertise
2-19 in mental health facilities, appointed by the executive
2-20 commissioner;

2-21 (4) a representative of the Texas Higher Education
2-22 Coordinating Board, appointed by the commissioner of the
2-23 coordinating board;

2-24 (5) a representative of each nonprofit organization
2-25 described by Section 113.0052(4) that is part of the consortium,
2-26 designated by a majority of the members described by Subdivision
2-27 (1);

2-28 (6) a representative of a hospital system in this
2-29 state, designated by a majority of the members described by
2-30 Subdivision (1); ~~and~~

2-31 (7) a representative selected from among the regional
2-32 education service centers described by Section 113.0052(5),
2-33 appointed by the executive commissioner; and

2-34 (8) any other representative designated:

2-35 (A) under Subsection (b); or

2-36 (B) by a majority of the members described by
2-37 Subdivision (1) at the request of the executive committee.

2-38 SECTION 3. Section 113.0102, Health and Safety Code, is
2-39 amended to read as follows:

2-40 Sec. 113.0102. TERMS; VACANCY. (a) Except as provided by
2-41 Subsection (b), the executive committee shall establish:

2-42 (1) the terms of executive committee members; and

2-43 (2) procedures for the reappointment of members.

2-44 (b) An executive committee member described by Section
2-45 113.0101(a)(7) serves a two-year term and is eligible for
2-46 reappointment.

2-47 (c) A vacancy on the executive committee shall be filled in
2-48 the same manner as the original appointment.

2-49 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
