A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the recipients of opioid antagonists under the opioid  
3 antagonist program.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section [461A.059\(c\)](#), Health and Safety Code, is  
6 amended to read as follows:

7 (c) The executive commissioner may provide opioid  
8 antagonists under the program to emergency medical services  
9 personnel, first responders, public schools, institutions of  
10 higher education as defined by Section [481.134](#), community centers,  
11 and other persons likely to be in a position to respond to an opioid  
12 overdose.

13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
15 provided by Section [39](#), Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
17 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
