S.B. No. 934

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the eligibility of certain officers of a political
3 subdivision authorized to impose a tax or issue bonds to hold at the
4 same time certain other offices.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Chapter 180, Local Government Code, is amended
7 by adding Section 180.0055 to read as follows:

8 Sec. 180.0055. ELIGIBILITY OF CERTAIN ELECTED OR APPOINTED
9 OFFICERS TO HOLD CERTAIN OTHER OFFICES. (a) This section applies
10 only to an elected or appointed office of a political subdivision
11 authorized to impose a tax or issue bonds. This section applies only
12 to the extent it does not conflict with a provision of the state
13 constitution.

14 (b) An officer who holds an office to which this section
15 applies is not eligible to hold at the same time another office to
16 which this section applies.

17 SECTION 2. Not later than the effective date of this Act, an
18 officer who holds more than one office in violation of Section
19 180.0055, Local Government Code, as added by this Act, shall
20 resign, effective on that date, from each office necessary to allow
21 the officer to be in compliance with the requirement of that
22 section.

23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
