BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Section 51.7761(b), Education Code, is amended to read as follows: 7 An institution awarding a public work contract funded 8 (b) in whole or in part with state or local governmental money or 9 governmentally administered financial assistance, including the 10 issuance of debt guaranteed by this state or a local governmental 11 12 entity, money from ratepayers, or money from user fees, may not: 13 (1) prohibit, require, discourage, or encourage a person bidding on the public work contract, including a contractor 14 15 or subcontractor, from entering into or adhering to an agreement with a collective bargaining organization relating to the project; 16 17 or

(2) discriminate against 18 а person described by 19 Subdivision (1) based on the person's involvement in the agreement, including the person's: 20

21 (A) status or lack of status as a party to the 22 agreement; or 23 willingness or refusal to enter into the (B) 24 agreement.

1 SECTION 2. Section 2269.0541(a), Government Code, is
2 amended to read as follows:

(a) A governmental entity awarding a public work contract
funded <u>in whole or in part</u> with state <u>or local governmental money or</u>
<u>governmentally administered financial assistance</u>, including the
issuance of debt guaranteed by this state <u>or a local governmental</u>
entity, money from ratepayers, or money from user fees, may not:

8 (1) prohibit, require, discourage, or encourage a 9 person bidding on the public work contract, including a contractor 10 or subcontractor, from entering into or adhering to an agreement 11 with a collective bargaining organization relating to the project; 12 or

13 (2) discriminate against a person described by 14 Subdivision (1) based on the person's involvement in the agreement, 15 including the person's:

16 (A) status or lack of status as a party to the 17 agreement; or

18 (B) willingness or refusal to enter into the19 agreement.

20 SECTION 3. The changes made by this Act to Section 51.7761, Education Code, and Section 2269.0541, Government Code, apply only 21 to a public work contract for which an invitation for offers, 22 request for proposals, request for qualifications, or other similar 23 solicitation is first published or distributed on or after the 24 25 effective date of this Act. A public work contract for which an invitation for offers, request for proposals, 26 request for 27 qualifications, or other similar solicitation is first published or

1 distributed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the 2 law in effect at the time the invitation, request, or other 3 solicitation is published or distributed, and the former law is 4 continued in effect for that purpose.

5 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
