4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. The heading to Section 402.024, Government Code,
6	is amended to read as follows:
7	Sec. 402.024. DEFENSE OF DISTRICT ATTORNEY, COUNTY
8	ATTORNEY, OR GRAND JUROR.
9	SECTION 2. Section 402.024, Government Code, is amended by
10	adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
11	(c) The attorney general may defend a state district
12	attorney or a county attorney in an action in a federal court if:
13	(1) the district or county attorney is a defendant
14	because of the district or county attorney's office;
15	(2) the cause of action relates to the enforcement of a
16	state statute; and
17	(3) the district or county attorney requests the
18	attorney general's assistance in the defense.
19	SECTION 3. Section 402.024, Government Code, as amended by
20	this Act, applies only to a court action filed in federal court on
21	or after the effective date of this Act. A court action filed
22	before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in
23	effect on the date the action was filed, and the former law is
24	continued in effect for that purpose.
