- 14 because of the district or county attorney's office;
- 15 (2) the cause of action relates to the enforcement of a

- 17 (3) the district or county attorney requests the

- 19 SECTION 3. Section 402.024, Government Code, as amended by
- 20 this Act, applies only to a court action filed in federal court on
