## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

## AN ACT

2 relating to the affirmative defense to prosecution for a criminal 3 offense for persons acting under duress.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 8.05(c), Penal Code, is amended to read 6 as follows:

7 (c) Compulsion within the meaning of this section exists
8 only if the force or threat of force would render a <u>reasonable</u>
9 person <u>in the situation</u> of <u>the defendant</u> [<del>reasonable firmness</del>]
10 incapable of resisting the pressure.

SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 11 12 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 13 14 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 15 For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 16 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred 17 18 before that date.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
