- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 54.3531(a), Education Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The governing board of an institution of higher
- 8 education shall exempt from the payment of tuition and laboratory
- 9 fees charged by the institution for a criminal justice or law
- 10 enforcement course or courses an undergraduate student who:
- 11 (1) is employed as a peace officer, correctional
- 12 officer, or jailer by this state or by a political subdivision of
- 13 this state;
- 14 (2) is enrolled in a criminal justice or law
- 15 enforcement-related degree program at the institution;
- 16 (3) is making satisfactory academic progress toward
- 17 the student's degree as determined by the institution; and
- 18 (4) applies for the exemption at least one week before
- 19 the last date of the institution's regular registration period for
- 20 the applicable semester or other term.
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 54.3531, Education Code, as amended by
- 22 this Act, applies beginning with tuition and fees charged for the
- 23 2023 fall semester. Tuition and fees charged for an academic
- 24 period before that semester are governed by the law in effect

- 1 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the former
- 2 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
