1-21 relating to requiring approved alcohol seller training programs to  
 1-22 include training on recognizing and treating opioid-related drug  
 1-23 overdoses.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Section 106.14, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is  
 1-26 amended by adding Subsections (b-1) and (b-2) to read as follows:

1-27 (b-1) An approved seller training program described by  
 1-28 Subsection (b) must include training on:

1-29 (1) the signs and symptoms of an opioid-related drug  
 1-30 overdose; and

1-31 (2) the administration of an opioid antagonist.

1-32 (b-2) For the purposes of this section, "opioid antagonist"  
 1-33 and "opioid-related drug overdose" have the meanings assigned by  
 1-34 Section 483.101, Health and Safety Code.

1-35 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
