- 5 SECTION 1. Section 20A.02(b), Penal Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 (b) Except as otherwise provided by this subsection and
- 8 Subsection (b-1), an offense under this section is a felony of the
- 9 second degree. An offense under this section is a felony of the
- 10 first degree if:
- 11 (1) the applicable conduct constitutes an offense
- 12 under Subsection (a)(5), (6), (7), or (8), regardless of whether
- 13 the actor knows the age of the child at the time of the offense;
- 14 (2) the commission of the offense results in the death
- 15 of the person who is trafficked;
- 16 (3) the commission of the offense results in the death
- 17 of an unborn child of the person who is trafficked; or
- 18 (4) the actor<u>:</u>
- 19 <u>(A)</u> recruited, enticed, or obtained the
- 20 <u>trafficked person</u> [victim of the offense] from a:
- 21 <u>(i)</u> shelter or facility operating as a
- 22 residential treatment center that serves runaway youth, foster
- 23 children, the homeless, or persons subjected to human trafficking,

- (ii) correctional facility while the actor
- 2 was confined in the facility; or
- 3 (B) intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly
- 4 impeded the normal breathing or circulation of the blood of the
- 5 trafficked person by applying pressure to the person's throat or
- 6 neck or by blocking the person's nose or mouth.
- 7 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 8 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 9 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 10 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 11 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 12 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 13 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 14 before that date.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
