- 4 SECTION 1. Section 32.091(b), Election Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 (b) A judge or clerk may not be paid for more than two hours
- 7 [one hour] of work before the polls open, except for payment made
- 8 for work under Section 62.014(c). In a precinct in which voting
- 9 machines are used, a judge or clerk may not be paid for more than two
- 10 hours of work after the time for closing the polls or after the last
- 11 voter has voted, whichever is later.
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
