1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the authority of certain municipalities and local
1-22 government corporations to use certain tax revenue for certain
1-23 qualified projects.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Section 351.1015, Tax Code, is amended by
1-26 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (j) to read as
1-27 follows:

1-28 (b) This section applies only to a qualified project located
1-29 in:

1-30 (1) a municipality with a population of at least
1-31 650,000 but less than 750,000 according to the most recent federal
1-32 decennial census; or

1-33 (2) a municipality with a population of at least two
1-34 million.

1-35 (j) A local government corporation to which this subsection
1-36 applies may act as a municipality under this section and is
1-37 considered to be a municipality for purposes of this section. With
1-38 respect to a local government corporation to which this subsection
1-39 applies, the term "qualified project" includes a convention center
1-40 facility, a venue, and any related infrastructure. This subsection
1-41 applies only to a local government corporation that:

1-42 (1) is authorized to collect a municipal hotel
1-43 occupancy tax;

1-44 (2) is located in a county with a population of 3.3
1-45 million or more; and

1-46 (3) operates a convention center facility located not
1-47 more than three miles from the city hall of the municipality in
1-48 which the convention center facility is located.

1-49 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
