| 12 | (b) Notwithstanding any other law, a political subdivision,          |
| 13 | for the purpose of reducing greenhouse gas emissions or conserving   |
| 14 | <pre>natural resources, may not:</pre>                               |
| 15 | (1) adopt or enforce an ordinance, order, regulation,                |
| 16 | or other measure that prohibits or restricts the use or sale of a    |
| 17 | product that is otherwise permitted by state and federal law; or     |
| 18 | (2) enter into a contract that directly or indirectly                |
| 19 | prohibits the use or sale of any product that is otherwise permitted |
| 20 | by state and federal law.  |
| 21 | SECTION 2. Section 250.014(b)(2), Local Government Code, as          |

added by this Act, applies only to a contract entered into on or

after the effective date of this Act. A contract entered into

before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in

- 1 effect on the date the contract was entered into, and the former law
- 2 is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
