1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the authority of a political subdivision to regulate
 1-22 the use or sale of a product for the purpose of reducing greenhouse
 1-23 gas emissions.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-25 SECTION 1. Chapter 250, Local Government Code, is amended
 1-26 by adding Section 250.014 to read as follows:

1-27 Sec. 250.014. REGULATION OF PRODUCTS FOR EMISSIONS
 1-28 REDUCTION PROHIBITED. (a) In this section, "greenhouse gas
 1-29 emissions" has the meaning assigned by Section 382.05102, Health
 1-30 and Safety Code.

1-31 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, a political subdivision,
 1-32 for the purpose of reducing greenhouse gas emissions, may not adopt
 1-33 or enforce an ordinance, order, regulation, or other measure that
 1-34 prohibits or restricts the use or sale of a product that is
 1-35 otherwise permitted by state and federal law.

1-36 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-37 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-38 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-39 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-40 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
