## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to the titling, registration, and operation of an 3 autocycle. Δ BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 501.008(a), Transportation Code, 5 is 6 amended to read as follows: (a) In this section, "autocycle" means a motor vehicle, 7 other than a tractor, that is: 8 (1) designed to have when propelled not more than 9 three wheels on the ground; 10 (2) equipped with seat belts and a steering mechanism 11 12 [wheel]; 13 (3) equipped with seating that does not require the operator to straddle or sit astride the seat; and 14 15 (4) manufactured and certified to comply with federal safety requirements for a motorcycle. 16 SECTION 2. Section 502.005(a), Transportation Code, 17 is amended to read as follows: 18 (a) In this section, "autocycle" means a motor vehicle, 19 other than a tractor, that is: 20 (1) designed to have when propelled not more than 21 22 three wheels on the ground; 23 (2) equipped with seat belts and a steering mechanism [wheel]; 24

(3) equipped with seating that does not require the
 operator to straddle or sit astride the seat; and

3 (4) manufactured and certified to comply with federal4 safety requirements for a motorcycle.

5 SECTION 3. Section 661.0015, Transportation Code, is 6 amended to read as follows:

Sec. 661.0015. PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR FOR AUTOCYCLE. (a) In 8 this section, "autocycle" means a motor vehicle, other than a 9 tractor, that is:

10 (1) designed to have when propelled not more than 11 three wheels on the ground;

12 (2) equipped with <u>seat belts and</u> a steering <u>mechanism</u> 13 [wheel];

14 (3) equipped with seating that does not require the15 operator to straddle or sit astride the seat; and

16 (4) manufactured and certified to comply with federal17 safety requirements for a motorcycle.

(b) For purposes of this chapter, an autocycle is considered
to be a motorcycle, except that this chapter does not apply to an
autocycle that has a partially or fully enclosed cab.
