- 21 (h) The Legislative Budget Board shall conduct the study

- 8 (k) The Legislative Budget Board may consolidate the study

- 11 agencies.
- 12 (1) Based on the report required by this section, each
- 13 state agency shall identify opportunities for the consolidation of
- 14 personnel and resources into space owned by this state, or if
- 15 state-owned space is not available, into space leased by this
- 16 state.
- 17 (m) This section expires September 1, 2025.
- 18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
