- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E-1, Chapter 1603, Occupations Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 1603.2110 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1603.2110. PROHIBITED PRACTICES. (a) Except as
- 8 provided by Subsection (b), a person performing a barbering or
- 9 cosmetology service within the scope of a license or permit issued
- 10 under this subchapter may not:
- 11 (1) make an incision into the dermis layer of a
- 12 person's skin, including for purposes of injecting a medication or
- 13 <u>other substance; or</u>

- 14 (2) use a prescription medical device approved by the
- 15 United States Food and Drug Administration.
- 16 (b) A person holding a license or permit issued under this
- 17 subchapter may perform an act described by Subsection (a) as part of
- 18 <u>a barbering or cosmetology service if the person is licensed to</u>
- 19 perform that act in this state or is otherwise authorized by law to
- 20 perform that act. In a disciplinary action by the commission
- 21 related to an act in violation of Subsection (a), the license or
- 22 permit holder has the burden of proving by a preponderance of the
- 23 evidence that the person is licensed or otherwise authorized to
- 24 perform the act.

- 1 (c) This section does not affect the authority of another
- 2 state agency regulating a profession to enforce any law related to
- 3 that profession.
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 1603.2110, Occupations Code, as added by
- 5 this Act, applies only to conduct that occurs on or after the
- 6 effective date of this Act. Conduct that occurs before the
- 7 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 8 date the conduct occurred, and the former law is continued in effect
- 9 for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
