8	(1) "Active duty" means current full-time military
9	service in the armed forces of the United States.
10	(2) "Armed forces of the United States" means the
11	army, navy, air force, space force, coast guard, or marine corps of
12	the United States or a reserve unit of one of those branches of the
13	armed forces.
14	(3) "Federal special investigator" means a person
15	described by Article 2.122, Code of Criminal Procedure.
16	(4) "Military veteran" means a person who has served
17	on active duty and who was discharged or released from active duty.
18	(b) A person is not eligible to serve as sheriff unless the
19	person:
20	(1) has a high school diploma or a high school
21	equivalency certificate; and
22	(2) <u>either:</u>
23	(A) holds an active permanent peace officer
24	license under Chapter 1701, Occupations Code; or

1 (B) is eligible to be licensed under Sections 2 1701.309 and 1701.312, Occupations Code, and: (i) has a minimum of five years 3 of 4 experience as a federal special investigator; or 5 (ii) is a military veteran with a minimum of 10 years of combined active duty or national guard service 6 7 experience. (c) A person is not eligible to be a candidate for the office 8 9 of sheriff unless the person holds an active permanent peace officer license under Chapter 1701, Occupations Code, or is a 10 11 person described by Subsection (b)(2)(B)(i) or (ii) and obtains a license within the time provided by Section 1701.302(a), 12 13 Occupations Code. SECTION 2. Section 1701.302(a), Occupations 14 Code, is 15 amended to read as follows: 16 (a) Except as provided by Section 85.0011, Local Government Code, an [An] officer, including a sheriff, elected under the Texas 17 Constitution or a statute or appointed to fill a vacancy in an 18 elective office must obtain a license from the commission not later 19 20 than the second anniversary of the date the officer takes office. SECTION 3. Section 85.0025, Local Government Code, 21 is repealed. 22

SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act to Sections 85.0011 and 85.0025, Local Government Code, do not apply to a sheriff serving a term that began before the effective date of this Act. A sheriff serving a term that began before the effective date of this Act is governed for the remainder of that term by Sections

1 85.0011 and 85.0025, Local Government Code, as those laws existed 2 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the prior law 3 is continued in effect for that purpose.

4 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
