## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the operation of a hospital at home program by certain
3	hospitals; authorizing a fee.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 241, Health and Safety Code, is amended
6	by adding Subchapter M to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER M. HOSPITAL AT HOME PROGRAM
8	Sec. 241.401. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
9	(1) "Acute hospital care at home waiver program"
10	means:
11	(A) the program established by the Centers for
12	Medicare and Medicaid Services under 42 U.S.C. Section 1320b-5 that
13	waives the requirements of 42 C.F.R. Sections 482.23(b) and (b)(1);
14	and
15	(B) a successor program to the program described
16	by Paragraph (A) that is established by the United States Congress
17	or the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services.
18	(2) "Hospital at home program" means a program
19	operated by a hospital to provide in a home setting health care
20	services that are considered to be acute hospital care for purposes
21	of the acute hospital care at home waiver program.
22	Sec. 241.402. APPROVAL AND LICENSE REQUIRED. (a) A
23	hospital may not operate a hospital at home program unless the
24	hospital:

- 1 (1) is approved by the Centers for Medicare and
- 2 Medicaid Services to operate the program; and
- 3 (2) holds a license issued by the commission under
- 4 this subchapter.
- 5 Sec. 241.403. MINIMUM STANDARDS. (a) The executive
- 6 <u>commissioner shall adopt rules establishing minimum standards for</u>
- 7 the operation of a hospital at home program by a hospital.
- 8 (b) The standards established under Subsection (a) must be
- 9 at least as stringent as the standards established by the Centers
- 10 for Medicare and Medicaid Services under the acute hospital care at
- 11 home waiver program.
- 12 Sec. 241.404. APPLICATION; ISSUANCE OF LICENSE. (a) An
- 13 applicant for a license under this subchapter must:
- 14 (1) submit an application to the commission in the
- form and manner prescribed by the commission; and
- 16 (2) pay a fee in the amount set by the commission under
- 17 Section 241.405.
- 18 (b) The commission shall issue a license to an applicant to
- 19 operate a hospital at home program under this subchapter if the
- 20 applicant meets the standards established under Section 241.403 and
- 21 satisfies the requirements of this section.
- (c) The commission may request that an applicant provide
- 23 additional information necessary to determine whether the
- 24 applicant meets the standards established under Section 241.403
- 25 after the applicant has submitted an application.
- Sec. 241.405. FEES. (a) The commission may establish a fee
- 27 to be assessed for the issuance of a license under this subchapter.

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- 1 (b) The commission must set the fee in an amount that is
- 2 reasonable and necessary to cover the costs of administering this
- 3 <u>subchapter</u>.
- 4 Sec. 241.406. WAIVER OF REQUIREMENTS. (a) The commission
- 5 by order may waive or modify a requirement of a particular provision
- 6 of this subchapter or a standard established under this subchapter
- 7 if the commission determines that the waiver or modification:
- 8 (1) will facilitate a hospital's creation or operation
- 9 of a hospital at home program; and
- 10 (2) is in the best interests of the individuals who are
- or will be served by the hospital's hospital at home program.
- 12 (b) Sections 241.026(d) and (e) apply to a waiver or
- 13 modification under this section.
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
