2	relating to social workers employed by school districts.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 33, Education Code, is
5	amended by adding Section 33.905 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 33.905. SOCIAL WORKERS. (a) In this section, "school
7	social work services" means services specialized to assist students
8	and families and designed to alleviate barriers to learning,
9	connect the home, the community, and the school, advocate for the
10	best interest and academic success of students, strengthen
11	relationships, and assist with basic and biopsychosocial needs.
12	(b) A social worker employed by a school district:
13	(1) shall:
14	(A) collaborate with district administrators and
15	other district professionals to enhance students' learning
16	environments;
17	(B) as appropriate, serve on district committees
18	that address education and safety issues for students; and
19	(C) collaborate with parents, teachers, district
20	administrators, and the community to develop and implement school
21	violence prevention, suicide prevention, and child abuse
22	identification strategies; and
23	(2) may provide:
24	(A) school social work services to students and

- 1 families in the district; and
- 2 (B) behavioral health referrals and group
- 3 <u>intervention services as needed.</u>
- 4 (c) The board of trustees of a school district may adopt a
- 5 policy that requires a social worker employed by the district to
- 6 spend at least 80 percent of the social worker's total work time on
- 7 <u>duties described by this section.</u>
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024
- 9 school year.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
