BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 182.054, Utilities Code, is amended to 1-24 1-25 read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 182.054. EXCEPTIONS. This subchapter does not prohibit a government-operated utility from disclosing personal 1-27 1-28 information in a customer's account record to:

1-29 (1) an official or employee of the state, a political 1-30 subdivision of the state, or the United States acting in an official 1-31 capacity;

1-32 (2) an employee of a utility acting in connection with 1-33 the employee's duties; 1-34
