- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 46.04(b), Penal Code, is amended to read
- 7 as follows:
- 8 (b) A person who has been convicted of an offense under
- 9 Section 22.01, punishable as a Class A misdemeanor and committed
- 10 against an individual whose relationship to or association with the
- 11 person is described by Section 71.0021(b), 71.003, or 71.005,
- 12 <u>Family Code</u> [involving a member of the person's family or
- 13 household], commits an offense if the person possesses a firearm
- 14 before the fifth anniversary of the later of:
- 15 (1) the date of the person's release from confinement
- 16 following conviction of the misdemeanor; or
- 17 (2) the date of the person's release from community
- 18 supervision following conviction of the misdemeanor.
- 19 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 20 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 21 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 22 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 23 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 24 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the

- 1 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense was
- 2 committed before that date.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
